**Steve says, “Look these opportunities over and let me know your availability right away!”:**

**Away down South, in Dixie,** is a great little camp in an out-of-the-way place that needs some 12x12 tile laid and other jobs done beginning in November. There is room for three RV's with full hook-ups – not Florida, but close!

**At a camp in the hill country of Texas,** up to three RV'ers for Christ units are needed, beginning in December. Just let Steve know so that he can coordinate with the camp. Details on planned projects are coming out soon. Rendezvous 2024 will likely be held here next April. Get a head start on knowing your way around the camp!

**Down in sunny, central Florida,** this coming January 2<sup>nd</sup> thru Feb. 28<sup>th</sup> will be the winter work session at one of our favorite camps. The folks who came last year have all decided to return (surprise, surprise!), so currently, we don't have any RV spots available. If you want to help here, let Steve know and he will develop a waiting list. We have 8 roofs to replace along with other work.

**There's at least one castle in Colorado Springs that needs upgrading** – Specialty skills are still needed this winter as the interior update begins. They need to double the electrical capacity, replace hundred-year-old plumbing systems, add new HVAC, and install fire suppression – all while keeping two-thirds of the facility open for ministry use, and without destroying the historical work and appearance of the building. Easy-peasy, right? Contact us to find out what's going on there and when there might be an opening for you to participate.

**A midsized Baptist church in southeast Minnesota is busting at the seams,** and with the help of a contractor they've added a large, new auditorium with future office and classroom spaces. We're asked to do interior wood framing including first floor walls and second floor joists and subfloor installation this fall but permit issues have delayed the slab pour. We will not be going to this project this year. Steve will confirm when the start in the spring of 2024 will be.

**If you don't take a wrong turn in Albuquerque, New Mexico**, you'll discover an international ministry, launched in 2018, that has trained about 45,000 believers in 43 countries. The next stage is to finish the remodel of the building they just bought, to bring leaders from these many countries to train here. A general contractor will get all necessary drawings and permits, and work with us as we volunteer in the remodel. Mike and Kime Kunkle are there and hope you will join them. If you are planning on going there, Steve MUST be notified. There are only two RV spots now, and the Kunkles occupy one of them. The ministry is willing to make arrangements for others, as soon as we know you are coming for sure.

**Overall ministry update** – We were very glad that many had the chance to meet Kyle Green at the Northeast Muster at the camp in Upstate New York last month. We've received good comments about the event, with many looking forward to attending the Rendezvous next spring for more of the same, but in Texas!

**We cannot express our thanks enough for all the time and effort our RV'ers for Christ put into these projects. We could not do this without them. Together we are helping other ministries make an impact for the Kingdom of God.**
