NAME: Warm Beach Camp Ministries, Stanwood WA.

LOCATION: 20800 Marine Dr. Stanwood WA. 98292.

PROJECT TEAM LEADER: Dave Armstrong. 303-842-4031.

PROJECT DATES: Starting July 2024 and into September 2024.

ACCOMODATION: 14+ up to 40' full hook up for RV with 50 amp available. There will be other people there so confirm with Dave Armstrong your arrival and length of stay.

LAUNDRY: Coin operated at the site.

MEALS: Meals provide on days we work.

SCOPE OF WORK: Remove and replace a large amount of wooden fencing. There is a tractor set up to do so. Build a new corral. Build two new 10X10 loafing sheds. (shed roof/ pole style). Materials will be on site and ready to go. www.warmbeach.com. Look their website over. There is a lot of info.

NAME: Energize Ministries.

LOCATION: 1315 Serenity Lane, Martinsville, VA. 24112.

PROJECT TEAM LEADER: Dave Williamson. 360-270-7253

PROJECT DATES: Dave will be there August 16th thru August 28th 2024. There is an Energize director at the camp and if you want to come earlier or stay later contact Dave Williamson and Dave will set that up.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Five RV sites.

LAUNDRY: At the site.

MEALS: Some meals are provided. There is a full kitchen for us to use to do group meals if desired.

SCOPE OF WORK: Three small rooms to convert to living spaces. Two trailers to be built as tiny homes. One has been finished and the materials and design are provided. Split rail fences need the rotten posts replaced. The windows at the lodge need replaced. See www.energizeministries.com to see what they do.

NAME: Midwest Bible Baptist Church.

LOCATION: 5930 Bandel Road NW, Rochester MN.

PROJECT TEAM LEADER: Steve Voreis. 206-602-5804

PROJECT DATES: I will be there (Steve Voreis) March 18th for up to 5 weeks. Then Duane Atkinson will be there May 10th to do drywall finish. There is much to do at this time.

ACCOMMODATION: 2 RV sites at the church. There is a parsonage at the site not lived in and is a full house with I think 5 bedrooms. I will be at the parsonage so the RV sites are available.

LAUNDRY: At the site.

MEALS: Lunch provided, some other meals depending on how many volunteers there are.

SCOPE OF WORK: March 18th starts the rough in for five gas packs. I have a set of plans, materials at the site with a design walk thru with the HVAC contractor on May 18th. I am a lifetime HVAC person and have done many similar projects. Duane Atkinson arrives May 10th to do drywall finish. Much to do at this time.

NAME: Newell Christian Fellowship.

LOCATION: 308 4th Street, Newell SD. (About 1 hour North of Sturgis SD)

PROJECT TEAM LEADER: NEEDED.

PROJECT DATES: Their hope is to start June 2024.

ACCOMMODATION: The project will reserve sites at the R&R campground in Newell SD.

LAUNDRY: Available.

MEALS: Breakfast and lunch provided during work days.

SCOPE OF WORK: A few years ago the church was built to dry in status. The request is to finish the inside. The framing is completed and everything else is needed. There is an electric contractor who will provide permits and electric layouts and have inspections once the electric rough in is completed. The plumbing will be stubbed into the crawl space and needs completely installed. Hot and cold-water lines and drainage. HVAC needs design and install. Drywall, flooring, all finish work, etc.

ACCOMMODATION: Two RV spots.

LAUNDRY: On property

MEALS: Provided.

SCOPE OF WORK: Siding and windows need installed. Duane Atkinson will be there during March and into April doing drywall. The pastor has what is needed and direction for the other items.

Overall ministry update – 2024 is off to a great start. Kyle has been meeting with local ministries in Krum, Denton and Dallas area who are looking for our assistance. This is an answer to prayer, as Kyle has been praying for a job to come up locally so we can have an opportunity to bring on local volunteers which could lead to potential recruits. Currently there are 5 projects on the horizon locally in Denton / Krum Area. Also, even though this update only shows (8) projects, we have a total of 14 projects that are in the works for 2024 that will need assistance. Dave is still focused and is working on the development of our TOOLBOX Topics and future development of devotional materials for our jobsite and construction industry partners. We currently have 14 projects and are setting a goal to raise \$5,000 per project to help offset travel costs for our missionaries. If you are not able to work physically on projects, we ask that you consider donating to either the General Fund or Missionary Support Fund to help offset travel costs to and from projects.
